

In Greek mythology Achilles was the strongest and the quickest of the Greek warriors who fought in the Trojan War. When he was a small child, his mother, Thetis, wanted her son to be a very strong soldier so she washed him in the River Styx and made every part of his body <u>invulnerable</u> – except the heel, because she held him by <u>this part</u>. His mother knew that he would die at Troy, so she tried to stop her son, but <u>he</u> was found there by Odysseus, and Odysseus persuaded him to join the army.

In the tenth year of the war, Achilles stopped fighting after Agamemnon had captured Briseis, his favorite slave girl. He stayed in his tent sadly, without doing anything, until his closest friend was killed by Hector. Then he returned to battle again. Achilles punished Hector by killing <u>him</u> in a duel and as it wasn't enough for him, he dragged Hector's body seven times around the walls of Troy. That was the end of the war. Achilles died shortly after Hector, when he was wounded in his heel – his only weak spot in his body.
